I guarantee the health of this pet. Within 3 working days you are required to take the pup to a vet within this period of time to get a well puppy exam. If the vet detects any life threatening problems, a full refund will be provided. When taking the new pet to the vet, I suggest you take a stool sample to check for parasites. Do not have pup routinely wormed unless the pup has worms, wormer is strong medication and pups that do not have parasites need not have it. I strongly suggest to get the pet on a vaccination schedule ASAP to complete the vaccination process as suggested by your vet. I also do not recommend taking your pet to unfamiliar places like the park, pet stores or other places where strange/unfamiliar animals may have defecated. Until fully vaccinated pups/dogs are very susceptible to disease, your vet will let you know when the vaccinations are complete.

Pups may not eat a lot at first, don't panic, just mix a small amount of canned puppy food, warm water and then dry food together, this tends to stimulate appetite. I always send food home with the pup. We feed Nutro Max Puppy Food which is in a purple bag and you can get it at any major pet or feed store. You can either keep them on the food they have been eating or change them to whatever you prefer. I suggest placing them on a feeding schedule. AM/PM is preferable. It helps the potty training process. I also strongly suggest crate training pups until they are potty trained. It may seem difficult at first but the pets eventually end up liking having their own "den" so to speak. I also suggest feeding puppy food to the age of 12 months. I strongly recommend eventually placing the pups on a diet of dry food and limiting treats which helps to prevent periodontal disease & overweight problems, which could both cause health problems.

If for some reason, you are unable to care for this pet, I would like to be notified to exercise the option of regaining possession of the pet and finding a suitable home, my first priority is to place chihuahuas in the best possible homes.
